Discussion

**Temp. Ord. A-71**

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor to enter into a license agreement, according to law, to allow Kentucky Data Link, Inc. access to the City's rights of way and electric poles and declaring an emergency.

Mr. Arrington stated this is the license agreement ordinance similar to what the City has done in the past with other companies. Kentucky Data Link is out of Indiana. They want to use poles to install fiber optic. It would start in Cuyahoga Falls but will mostly be in Akron. They will be using 20 of the City's poles, and will pay \$23 per pole per year. It is what we have always done. Mr. Ihasz asked when they would start. Mr. Arrington stated it would be as soon as possible. They are waiting on the passage of this ordinance.
