

SWIM LESSON PROGRAM

The Natatorium offers swimming instruction for all ages and all levels of ability. This includes everything from introducing infants to the water, to lifeguard training.

Natatorium swim lesson instructors are certified by the American Red Cross in Lifeguard Training, CPR for the Professional Rescuer, Automated External Defibrillator, Oxygen Use and Preventing Disease Transmission. Concerns about level placement must be handled prior to registration with the aquatics coordinator.
