



## Fridays & Saturdays Natatorium Youth Policy

**In an effort to continue fostering a family atmosphere at the Natatorium and to continue to meet the needs of all patrons and guests a new youth policy will be in effect beginning October 24, 2008. Below is the new policy. Feel free to call the Natatorium Operations Supervisor at 330-971-8080 with any questions.**

1. Natatorium members and/or guests, 15 years of age or younger, must be accompanied by a legal guardian/parent on Fridays and Saturdays after 5 pm. The legal guardian/parent must stay with the child in The Natatorium at all times.
2. Anyone 16 years of age or older must show a photo ID at the Welcome Desk to gain access into the facility.
3. Children, 15 years of age and younger, need to check in at the Welcome Desk with their legal guardian/parent and be issued a wristband that must be worn the entire night.
4. Any child, 15 years of age and younger, who is in the facility prior to 5 pm, must leave the facility at 5 pm, or be joined by a legal guardian/parent at the Welcome Desk.
5. Legal guardians/parents, may sponsor all of his/her children with proof of guardianship, or may sponsor up to 3 children, one being the child of the legal guardian/parent.
6. Children 15 years of age and younger will be charged the rate for where their legal guardian/parent shows proof of residency.
7. Legal guardians/children are responsible for the actions of their children/guests.
8. If a child does not comply with The Natatorium's guidelines, or the law, they may be asked to leave the facility for the night, for an extended period of time, or they may be banned indefinitely. Legal guardians/parents may also be suspended for the duration that the child is suspended or banned. No refunds will be given.



\*A legal guardian/parent is considered an individual who has legal custody of one or more children that is evidenced by a court document. Birth certificates/court documentation will be required before entry into the facility.
